#### Capital Reserve Contingency Fund

Several annual meetings ago, the community approved the establishment of a Capital Reserve Contingency Fund, which would provide us with funds to do major projects in Arnell Creek, such as replacing the pool house roof and resurfacing the tennis courts. The community authorized an additional \$50 per year, per property, to be collected along with the annual dues. The money is kept in a separate account and is used exclusively for these major improvements. You will notice that the annual Invoice for Membership Dues which is included with this newsletter, includes this amount. For your convenience, you can write just one check for both the Membership Dues and the Improvement Fund for a total of \$300.00.

#### Before you build or renovate, call Ralph!

The Arnell Creek Rules and Regulations require that all construction/renovations that affect the outside of your house (including fences) require Board approval before you start the work. We've made it easy for you – before you renovate, contact Ralph McCutcheon on Michael Court. He will provide you with the necessary forms and information you'll need to provide to the Board, to make approval for any renovation on your property an easy one. Also, if you plan to locate a *dumpster* for any length of time on your property, please let us know of your plans and how long you intend to have it there! Remember, dumpsters and port-a-potties *may not* be parked on the street.
